By simply swiping the Sure 'N Fast Counterfeit Detector over a dark printed area of the paper currency, you can tell if the currency is indeed real or counterfeit. If counterfeit the fiber applicator will turn black, and the counterfeit currency is defaced.

To clean a dirty applicator, simply swipe the tip on a clean piece of paper until the tip is clean. You are then ready to test another bill. The Sure 'N Fast Counterfeit Detector is good for testing over 1,000 bills.

Most cashiers will hold a large bill up to the light to check for the presence of the security strip. A security strip is a thin thread or ribbon running through a bank note substrate. The note's denomination is printed on the thread. However, it is so small that it is not legible to most people.

Cashiers also look for a watermark in the lower right hand corner of a bill. The watermark matches the face on the front of the bill. Oftentimes it is difficult to compare the watermark to the printed face due to lighting and age of a bill. Most cashiers have difficulty comparing the two images or do not pay close enough attention to notice a difference.
